

**PROPOSITION \_\_\_\_**  
**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2008**  
**hunting and fishing; constitutional rights**

**ANALYSIS BY LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

- 1            Proposition \_\_\_\_ would amend the Arizona Constitution to provide that:
- 2            1. Wildlife is held in trust for the citizens of this state, whom have a right to
- 3 lawfully hunt, fish and harvest the wildlife.
- 4            2. The legislature has the exclusive authority to enact laws to regulate hunting,
- 5 fishing and harvesting of wildlife. The legislature may grant rule making authority to a
- 6 game and fish commission. No law or rule shall unreasonably restrict hunting, fishing or
- 7 harvesting of wildlife or the use of traditional means and methods for those activities.
- 8 Any law or rule shall have the purpose of wildlife conservation and management and
- 9 preserving the future of hunting and fishing.
- 10           3. Lawful public hunting and fishing are the preferred means of managing and
- 11 controlling wildlife.
- 12           By its terms, nothing in Proposition \_\_\_\_ shall be construed to modify any law
- 13 relating to trespass or property rights.
