

**PROPOSITION \_\_\_\_**  
**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2014**  
**health care services; direct purchase**

**ANALYSIS BY LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

1 Proposition \_\_\_\_ would amend the Arizona Constitution to:

2 1. Prohibit any law or rule from compelling any person, employer or health care  
3 provider to participate in any health care system.

4 2. Allow a person or employer to pay directly for lawful health care services  
5 without being penalized or fined.

6 3. Allow a health care provider to accept direct payment for lawful health care  
7 services without being penalized or fined.

8 4. Provide that the purchase or sale of health insurance in private health care  
9 systems shall not be prohibited by law or rule, subject to reasonable and necessary rules  
10 that do not substantially limit a person's options.

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12 Proposition \_\_\_\_ would not:

13 1. Affect which health care services a health care provider or hospital is required  
14 to perform or provide.

15 2. Affect which health care services are permitted by law.

16 3. Prohibit care provided by law relating to worker's compensation.

17 4. Affect laws or rules in effect as of January 1, 2009.

18 5. Affect the terms or conditions of any health care system unless those terms and  
19 conditions have the effect of punishing a person or employer for paying directly for  
20 lawful health care services or punishing a health care provider or hospital for  
21 accepting direct payment from a person or employer for lawful health care services.
