Re: House Bill 2327 (motor vehicle; definition; exclusion; insurance)

Dear Secretary Bennett,

Today, I vetoed House Bill 2327. This bill would allow insurance companies to cancel or non-renew an auto insurance policy if the vehicle is principally garaged outside of Arizona. Many Arizona residents such as students and winter visitors split their time between Arizona and other states. The legislation, as drafted, does not define "principally garaged outside Arizona." As a result, the bill enables an insurance company to determine if a vehicle is principally garaged outside of Arizona. Furthermore, the legislation may have the unintended consequence of removing important consumer protections, such as receiving proper notice of the cancellation and the right to protest a cancellation, from customers.

These concerns are among the primary reasons I vetoed House Bill 2327.
