Re: Senate Bill 1201 (autocycles; class M license; exemption)

Dear President Biggs,

Today, I vetoed Senate Bill 1201. I do not oppose adding autocycles and motorized quadricycles to the definition section of the transportation statutes. However, the bill also allows motorized quadricycles to be licensed as limousines, which allows passengers to consume alcohol in these vehicles. This visible consumption of alcohol on public streets in these open air vehicles is inconsistent with our open container and public consumption laws. Furthermore, I am concerned that these vehicles could present a public safety risk and provide little protection to the passengers, particularly if these passengers are drinking alcohol. Law enforcement agencies also have expressed concerns regarding these issues.

These concerns are among the primary reasons I have vetoed Senate Bill 1201.
