Re: Senate Bill 1483 (county supervisors; population threshold; membership)

Dear Secretary Bennett,

Today, I vetoed Senate Bill 1483. This legislation would have modified the population threshold requirement for counties to change the number of members on the board of supervisors. Earlier today, I signed House Bill 2420, which contains identical provisions found in Senate Bill 1483, and also requires a cost estimate of each additional member to be added to the board of supervisors to be included in the election publicity pamphlet. Accordingly, signing Senate Bill 1483 would be redundant and unnecessary.

These concerns are among the primary reasons that I have vetoed Senate Bill 1483.
