While I understand the genesis behind the bill, I am concerned about the additional -- and subjective -- requirements it places on businesses and entrepreneurs. I support reducing frivolous lawsuits in the state, but this bill would not insulate any business from litigation and in fact could actually expose trademark applicants to additional litigation due to the new requirements contained in the bill.
