- Completed and signed application.
- Resume.
- Two letters of reference from people who can discuss your legal or academic skills. Include at least one letter from a previous employer in the legal field, if possible.
- A short personal statement of interest in the program, approximately one page.
- A brief (not more than two pages) writing sample (short legal memorandum prepared for a legal employer, if possible) that demonstrates your legal research and writing skills. If this is not possible, a sample not more than five pages that includes legal research and analysis.

Your official transcript will be included with your application packet by the Law School.
