**LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY** — *The legislative authority of the state is vested in the Legislature by the Constitution. The Legislature consists of a Senate and a House of Representatives elected by the voters of Arizona. In addition to the staff employed by each body of the Legislature, there are 4 state agencies that are established within the legislative branch and governed by statutorily created committees of the Legislature. They are: the Auditor General, the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, the Legislative Council, and the Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records.*

**Technical Adjustments** — The FY 2004 approved amounts for the House of Representatives and Senate include technical adjustments for Employee Related Expenditures, and Risk Management charges. *(Please see the General Provisions section at the end of this Appropriations Report for further details on these changes.)*
