**AGENCY DESCRIPTION** — The Senate is made up of 30 members elected from each of the legislative districts. The officers and employees of the Senate consist of the President of the Senate, a Secretary of the Senate, and other employees as the Senate directs.

**Operating Budget**

The budget provides \$8,693,000 from the General Fund for the operating budget in FY 2007. The amount includes an increase of \$468,400 from the General Fund for statewide adjustments. *(Please see the Statewide Adjustments section at the end of this Appropriations Report for details.)*

**Additional Legislation**

**Notification of Alleged Unconstitutional Enactment**

The Criminal Justice Budget Reconciliation Bill (Laws 2006, Chapter 348) as permanent law, requires that, in addition to the Attorney General, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate be notified of any proceeding in which a state statute, ordinance, franchise or rule is alleged to be unconstitutional.
