

	<u>Other Fund</u>	
- Securities Investigators' Pay Parity	0	243.2
• Currently, Corporation Commission Investigators starting salary is \$47,000		
• Executive would increase pay for 9 FTE and raise starting salary to \$69,200		
• Corporation Commission reports turnover rates of 126% over five year period		
• Attorney General hires investigators at \$68,000 and Maricopa County Attorney's Office investigator pay ranges from \$56,000 to \$85,000
