**Agency Description** — *The Geological Survey investigates Arizona's geology and regulates the drilling and production of oil, gas, and other energy resources. The Survey also provides technical advice and assistance to state and local government agencies, industry, and other members of the public concerning the geologic environment and the development and use of mineral resources in Arizona.*

**Administrative Reclassifications** — The approved FY 2000 amount includes an increase of \$6,300 to reclassify 5 FTE Positions, as approved by the Arizona Department of Administration. This amount is continued in FY 2001.

**Replacement Equipment** — The approved FY 2000 amount includes one-time funding of \$13,600 to replace 3 computers and 1 copier. The approved FY 2001 amount includes one-time funding of \$12,400 to replace an additional 3 computers and 1 copier.
