

**VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS BY DISTRICTS**  
**(SALT RIVER PROJECT)**

DESCRIPTION

*Voluntary contributions by districts refers to “voluntary” contributions made by special districts, such as power districts, to the state or political subdivisions in lieu of property taxes. The Legislature provided this plan to encourage special districts to operate as multi-purpose reclamation projects to provide funds for water conservation and maintenance and development of their water distribution systems. Effectively, this law applies mainly to properties included within the Salt River Project.*
