

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS BY THE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION

DESCRIPTION

Voluntary contributions by the Game and Fish Commission refers to voluntary contributions that the Commission may make to the state or a political subdivision in lieu of property taxes when it purchases land. Contribution amounts are figured by determining the property's assessed valuation and applying the property tax rate.
