AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 34, CHAPTER 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 1;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; RELATING TO STATE BUILDINGS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 34, chapter 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding article 1, to read:

4 ARTICLE 1. STATE BUILDINGS

5 34-401. New and renovated state buildings; automated external
6 defibrillators

7 A. ANY STATE BUILDING THAT IS CONSTRUCTED OR THAT UNDERGOES A MAJOR
8 RENOVATION AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH
9 AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

10 B. FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
11 JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STRATEGIC
12 PLANNING AND BUDGETING SHALL INCLUDE FUNDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF AUTOMATED
13 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS IN CAPITAL BUDGETS FOR NEW STATE BUILDINGS.

14 Sec. 2. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

15 A. The sum of \$250,000 is appropriated from the emergency medical
16 services operating fund established by section 36-2218, Arizona Revised
17 Statutes, in fiscal year 2002-2003 to the department of administration for
18 placement of automated external defibrillators in existing state buildings.

19 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
20 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
21 lapsing of appropriations.
