AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 34-451, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ENERGY CONSERVATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 34-451, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 34-451. Energy conservation standards for public buildings

5 A. The department of commerce in consultation with persons responsible
6 for building systems shall adopt and publish energy conservation standards
7 for construction of all new capital projects as defined in section 41-790,
8 including buildings designed and constructed by school districts, community
9 college districts and universities. These standards shall be consistent with
10 the recommended energy conservation standards of the American society of
11 heating, refrigerating, ~~and~~ and air conditioning engineers and the international
12 ~~conference of building officials~~ ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE.

13 B. The standards shall be ~~promulgated~~ ADOPTED to achieve energy
14 conservation and shall allow for design flexibility.

15 C. THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION SHALL REDUCE ENERGY USE IN STATE
16 BUILDINGS BY TEN PER CENT PER SQUARE FOOT OF FLOOR AREA ON OR BEFORE JULY 1,
17 2008 AND BY FIFTEEN PER CENT PER SQUARE FOOT OF FLOOR AREA ON OR BEFORE
18 JULY 1, 2011, USING JULY 1, 2002 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2003 AS THE BASELINE YEAR.
19 ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION SHALL
20 REPORT TO THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT OF
21 THE SENATE AS TO THE PROGRESS OF ATTAINING THE GOALS PRESCRIBED IN THIS
22 SUBSECTION.

23 D. ALL STATE AGENCIES SHALL PROCURE ENERGYSSTAR PRODUCTS IN ALL
24 CATEGORIES THAT ARE AVAILABLE UNLESS THE PRODUCTS ARE SHOWN NOT TO BE
25 COST-EFFECTIVE ON A LIFE CYCLE COST BASIS.
