AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2002, CHAPTER 327, SECTION 117, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2002, SIXTH SPECIAL SESSION, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 61; RELATING TO SURPLUS MATERIALS FUND MONIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 2002, chapter 327, section 117, as amended by Laws  
3 2002, sixth special session, chapter 1, section 61, is amended to read:

6 Notwithstanding any other law, on or before June 30, 2003, the
