AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 18, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-1110; RELATING TO VEHICLE SIZE, WEIGHT AND LOAD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 3, article 18, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 28-1110, to read:

4 28-1110. Pilot car training and certification requirements:
5 definition

6 A. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT RULES TO ESTABLISH PILOT CAR OPERATOR
7 TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS. THE RULES SHALL:

8 1. ESTABLISH TRAINING, CERTIFICATION AND OPERATING REQUIREMENTS.

9 2. PERMIT THE DEPARTMENT TO AUTHORIZE THIRD PARTIES TO CONDUCT PILOT
10 CAR OPERATOR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 13 OF THIS TITLE.

11 3. ESTABLISH FEES IN AN AMOUNT TO BE DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR.

12 4. PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR PILOT CARS THAT VIOLATE OVERDIMENSIONAL OR
13 OVERWEIGHT LOAD REQUIREMENTS.

14 5. EXEMPT LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ENGAGED IN THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

15 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "PILOT CAR" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE
16 THAT ESCORTS OVERDIMENSIONAL OR OVERWEIGHT LOADS ON ANY STREET OR HIGHWAY IN
17 THIS STATE.
