1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Sections 48-6002 and 48-6004, Arizona Revised Statutes, are repealed
4 from and after June 30, 2010.

5 Sec. 2. Title 48, chapter 35, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
6 amended by adding section 48-6009, to read:

7 48-6009. Termination of formation authority; existing
8 districts; effect on financial provisions

9 A. BEGINNING JULY 1, 2010, A NEW DISTRICT MAY NOT BE FORMED PURSUANT
10 TO THIS CHAPTER.

11 B. THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO:

12 1. LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OR OTHERWISE AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF ANY
13 DISTRICT FORMED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER BEFORE JULY 1, 2010.

14 2. AFFECT THE VALIDITY OR ENFORCEABILITY OF ANY LEGAL OR FINANCIAL
15 OBLIGATION OR BENEFIT INCURRED BY A DISTRICT FORMED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER
16 BEFORE JULY 1, 2010 WITHOUT REGARD TO WHEN THE LEGAL OR FINANCIAL OBLIGATION
17 OR BENEFIT IS INCURRED.
