SENATE BILL 1257

AN ACT

REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARDS TO VOTE TO ADOPT OR REJECT
TECHNOLOGY STANDARDS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. School districts: state board of education:
3 technology standards

4 A. The state board of education shall post technology standards
5 adopted by the government information technology agency established by title
6 41, chapter 32, Arizona Revised Statutes, on a web site maintained by the
7 state board of education.

8 B. A school district governing board shall hold a public meeting at
9 which the governing board members vote on the adoption or rejection of the
10 technology standards adopted by the government information technology agency
11 established by title 41, chapter 32, Arizona Revised Statutes, within one
12 year after the effective date of this act. The technology personnel employed
13 by the school district may present exceptions to these technology standards
14 at that public meeting for the school district governing board's
15 consideration.

16 C. If a school district governing board votes to adopt the technology
17 standards adopted by the government information technology agency established
18 by title 41, chapter 32, Arizona Revised Statutes, the school district shall
19 comply with those technology standards for all technology purchases made
20 until July 1, 2010.

21 Sec. 2. Delayed repeal

22 This act is repealed from and after June 30, 2010.
