AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR CANCER  
RESEARCH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation: health care institutions: cancer  
3 research and treatment: exemption

4 A. The sum of \$15,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund  
5 in fiscal year 2009-2010 to the department of health services for  
6 distribution to health care institutions in Maricopa and Pima counties that  
7 are designated by the National Cancer Institute to perform research,  
8 treatment, education and preventive research into cancers that are unique to  
9 women. The department shall distribute these monies as follows:

10 1. The sum of \$10,000,000 for institutions in Maricopa county.

11 2. The sum of \$5,000,000 for institutions in Pima county.

12 B. The amount distributed to each institution by the department shall  
13 equal one-third of monies raised by the institution within an eighteen month  
14 period ending June 30, 2009. If in either county a full state match would  
15 exceed the amount appropriated pursuant to subsection A of this section, the  
16 department shall reduce proportionately the distribution to each qualifying  
17 institution.

18 C. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
19 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
20 lapsing of appropriations until January 1, 2011.
