# HOUSE BILL 2248

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 25, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 25-515; RELATING TO FAMILY SUPPORT DUTIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 25, chapter 5, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 25-515, to read:

4 25-515. Title IV-D recipients; fee

5 A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CHARGE AND WITHHOLD AN ANNUAL FEE OF  
6 TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FROM EACH RECIPIENT OF TITLE IV-D SERVICES WHO HAS NEVER  
7 RECEIVED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WITHHOLD THIS FEE FROM THE  
8 FIRST PAYMENT TO THE RECIPIENT OF SUPPORT THAT EXCEEDS FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS  
9 EACH YEAR.

10 B. NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL  
11 CHARGE AND WITHHOLD AN ANNUAL FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FROM THE OBLIGOR IN  
12 A TITLE IV-D CASE WHO HAS NEVER RECEIVED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, IN CASES WHERE A  
13 FOREIGN COUNTRY HAS REQUESTED ENFORCEMENT OF A SUPPORT ORDER. THE DEPARTMENT  
14 SHALL WITHHOLD THIS FEE FROM THE FIRST PAYMENT THAT EXCEEDS FIVE HUNDRED  
15 DOLLARS EACH YEAR.

16 C. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ITS PORTION  
17 OF EACH FEE WITHHELD PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL  
18 DEPOSIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 35-146 AND 35-147, THE REMAINDER IN A CHILD  
19 SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION FUND.

20 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; two-thirds vote

21 Pursuant to article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, this act  
22 is effective only on the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the  
23 members of each house of the legislature and is effective immediately on the  
24 signature of the governor or, if the governor vetoes this act, on the  
25 subsequent affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of each  
26 house of the legislature.
