AMENDING TITLE 41, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 44; RELATING
TO VALID IDENTIFICATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding

7 41-4401. Valid identification; consular identification cards;

10 A CONSULAR IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT IS ISSUED BY A FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AS A
11 VALID FORM OF IDENTIFICATION.
