AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 381, SECTION 7; RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF THE UNITED STATES FLAG.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Laws 2006, chapter 381, section 7, is amended to read:
3 Sec. 7. Existing flags; display requirements
4 A. A United States flag that is ~~at least two feet by three feet~~ OF
5 SUFFICIENT SIZE TO BE VISIBLE AND EASILY RECOGNIZABLE AS A UNITED STATES
6 FLAG, THAT IS NOT MADE OF PAPER and THAT is present in a classroom at a
7 school district, charter school, community college or public university AND
8 displayed in accordance with title 4 of the United States Code as of June 30,
9 2006, may be used to meet the requirements of ~~this act~~ SECTION 15-506,
10 15-1445 OR 15-1626, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, UNTIL THAT FLAG NEEDS TO BE
11 REPLACED.
12 B. WHEN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHARTER SCHOOL, COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR PUBLIC
13 UNIVERSITY REPLACES AN EXISTING UNITED STATES FLAG THAT WAS LESS THAN TWO
14 FEET BY THREE FEET IN A CLASSROOM, THE REPLACEMENT FLAG SHALL BE AT LEAST TWO
15 FEET BY THREE FEET.
