AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 4-206.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 4-206.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 4-206.01. Bar, beer and wine bar or liquor store licenses;
5 number permitted; fee

6 A. The director shall determine the total number of spirituous liquor
7 licenses by type and in each county. The director shall publish a listing of
8 that information as determined by the director.

9 B. In each county, the director shall issue additional bar, beer and
10 wine bar or liquor store licenses at the rate of one of each type for each
11 additional ten thousand person increase over the population in that county as
12 of July 1, 2010. For purposes of this ~~paragraph~~ SUBSECTION, the population
13 of a county is deemed to be the population estimated by the department of
14 economic security as of July 1 of each year.

15 C. A person issued a license authorized by subsection B of this
16 section shall pay an additional issuance fee equal to the license's fair
17 market value which shall be paid to the state general fund. The fair market
18 value shall be defined to mean the mean value of licenses of the same type
19 sold on the open market in the same county during the prior twelve months,
20 but if there are not three or more such sales then the fair market value
21 shall be determined by three appraisals furnished to the department by
22 independent professional appraisers employed by the director.

23 D. The director shall employ professional appraisal services to
24 determine the fair market value of bar, beer and wine bar or liquor store
25 licenses.

26 E. If more than one person applies for an available license, a
27 priority of applicants shall be determined by a random selection method
28 prescribed by the director.
