AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-296.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PUBLIC OFFICERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-296.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 38-296.01. Limitation on running for multiple offices

5 A. A person is not eligible to be a candidate for nomination or
6 election to more than one public office if the elections for those offices
7 are held on the same day and if the person would be prohibited **BY THE ARIZONA**
8 **CONSTITUTION OR BY STATUTE** from serving in the offices simultaneously.

9 B. A person is not eligible to be a candidate for nomination or
10 election to and is not eligible to serve simultaneously on more than one
11 school district governing board, except that a member of a governing board
12 may be a candidate for nomination or election for any other governing board
13 if the member is serving in the last year of a term of office.
