AMENDING SECTION 26-166, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE NATIONAL
GUARD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 26-166, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 26-166. Immunity of national guard members on active duty:
5 arrest; civil actions; exemption from jury duty

6 A. A member of the national guard, unless charged with commission of a
7 felony, shall not be arrested while on active duty with the national guard in
8 camp, maneuvers or formations, or while engaged in armory drill, or while on
9 the way to or from such duties.

10 B. IN ANY CIVIL ACTION, A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL GUARD IS NOT LIABLE
11 FOR DAMAGES FOR AN ACT THAT OCCURS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE NATIONAL GUARD
12 MEMBER'S DUTIES.

13 ~~B.~~ C. A member of the national guard while on active duty shall not
14 be liable for jury duty.
