1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Board of regents; report; impact of increased high
3 school graduation requirements

4 A. The Arizona board of regents shall submit a report on or before
5 November 30, 2008 to the governor, the president of the senate and the
6 speaker of the house of representatives that examines the potential impact on
7 the universities under its jurisdiction as a result of the high school
8 graduation requirements adopted by the state board of education on December
9 10, 2007 in each of the following areas:

10 1. The current training and production of teachers who will provide
11 mathematics and science instruction to pupils in kindergarten programs and
12 grades one through twelve.

13 2. How the Arizona board of regents has planned or is planning to meet
14 the future needs for the training and production of teachers who will provide
15 mathematics and science instruction to pupils in kindergarten programs and
16 grades one through twelve.

17 3. The necessity for remedial courses to university students.

18 4. The implementation plan and the estimated cost of providing
19 regents' diplomas and other types of honors endorsements to academically
20 qualified pupils who graduate from high schools in this state that may be
21 established by the state board of education or the Arizona board of regents.

22 5. The percentage of high school pupils in this state who subsequently
23 enroll in college.

24 B. The Arizona board of regents shall provide a copy of this report to
25 the secretary of state and the director of the Arizona state library,
26 archives and public records."
