HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2215

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 28-3305, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-3305. Court action on conviction

5 A. If a person is convicted of an offense or if a judgment is entered
6 against the person for which revocation of the driver license of the person
7 by the department is mandatory pursuant to this chapter, the court that
8 ordered the conviction or judgment shall:

9 1. Require the person to surrender to the court all driver licenses
10 held by the person.

11 2. Invalidate or destroy the driver licenses.

12 3. Forward a record of the conviction or judgment to the department.

13 B. A court with jurisdiction over offenses or civil traffic violations
14 committed under this chapter, any other law of this state or a municipal
15 ordinance regulating the operation of motor vehicles on highways shall
16 forward a record of the conviction of or judgment against a person in the
17 court, except for a violation related to standing or parking, to the
18 department and may recommend the suspension of the driver license of the
19 person.

20 C. If a court declares that an entire civil penalty is due pursuant to
21 section 28-1601, the court shall immediately notify the department. After
22 payment of the civil penalty AND AFTER THE PERSON PAYS THE COURT A
23 REINSTATEMENT FEE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 28-3002 AND AN ADDITIONAL FEE IN AN
24 AMOUNT TO BE DETERMINED BY THE SUPREME COURT TO COVER ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS,
25 the court shall IMMEDIATELY give notice ~~immediately~~ TO THE DEPARTMENT of full
26 satisfaction of the civil penalty by a method approved by the department. IF
27 A PERSON IS FOUND RESPONSIBLE IN A JUSTICE COURT OR SUPERIOR COURT, THE COURT

1 SHALL TRANSMIT THE REINSTATEMENT FEE TO THE COUNTY TREASURER. IF A PERSON IS
2 FOUND RESPONSIBLE IN A MUNICIPAL COURT, THE COURT SHALL TRANSMIT THE
3 REINSTATEMENT FEE TO THE CITY TREASURER. THE CITY OR COUNTY TREASURER SHALL
4 TRANSMIT THE REINSTATEMENT FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER WHO SHALL TRANSMIT THE
5 REINSTATEMENT FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT. On ~~payment of a~~ RECEIVING THE NOTICE
6 AND THE reinstatement fee ~~as provided in section 28-3002~~, the department
7 shall terminate the suspension of a driver license, a driver permit or the
8 privilege of a nonresident to drive a motor vehicle in this state if no other
9 grounds for suspension exist. "
