AMENDING SECTION 28-2354, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO LICENSE
PLATES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 28-2354, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:
4 28-2354. License plates; attachment
5 A. A person shall display the license plate or plates as follows:
6 1. For a motor vehicle, motorcycle, trailer or semitrailer, on the
7 rear.
8 2. For a vehicle for which two license plates are issued, the vehicle
9 owner shall display either of the following:
10 (a) One plate on the rear.
11 (b) One plate on the front and one plate on the rear.
12 B. A person shall display all license plates as required by subsection
13 A until their lawful use expires or is canceled or revoked. A person shall
14 maintain each license plate so it is clearly legible ~~and so that the name of~~
15 ~~this state at the top of the license plate is not obscured~~. A person shall
16 securely fasten each license plate to the vehicle as follows:
17 1. To prevent the plate from swinging.
18 2. At a height of at least twelve inches from the ground to the bottom
19 of the plate.
20 3. In a position to be clearly visible.
