AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 13-3622, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-3622, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-3622. Furnishing of tobacco to minor; minor accepting or
5 receiving tobacco; classification; definition

6 A. A person who knowingly sells, gives or furnishes cigars,
7 cigarettes, **ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES** or cigarette papers, ~~OR~~ smoking or chewing
8 tobacco, ~~to~~ to a minor, and a minor who buys, or has in his possession or
9 knowingly accepts or receives from any person, cigars, cigarettes, **ELECTRONIC**
10 **CIGARETTES** or cigarette papers, ~~OR~~ smoking or chewing tobacco of any kind,
11 is guilty of a petty offense.

12 B. **FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE" MEANS A**
13 **BATTERY-POWERED DEVICE THAT CAN PROVIDE INHALED DOSES OF NICOTINE BY**
14 **DELIVERING A VAPORIZED SOLUTION.**
