AN ACT

IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON PAY RAISES FOR CERTAIN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICIALS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Elected official pay raises; fiscal years 2009-2010
3 and 2010-2011; moratorium; funding

4 Notwithstanding any other law, beginning on the effective date of this
5 act, a city, town, county, school district or special taxing district in this
6 state shall not spend public monies to increase the salary of any of its
7 elected public officials during fiscal year 2009-2010 and fiscal year
8 2010-2011 until after this state has enacted a balanced budget for those
9 fiscal years.

10 Sec. 2. Emergency

11 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
12 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
13 law.
