AMENDING SECTION 15-1646, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO UNIVERSITIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-1646, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 15-1646. Board of regents and university scholarships:
5 notification requirements

6 The ~~state-public~~ universities under the jurisdiction of the Arizona
7 board of regents shall establish AND PUBLISH ALL CRITERIA AND policies ~~which~~
8 ~~assure~~ THAT DETERMINE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND THAT ENSURE fair and
9 equitable access by Arizona students from public, private, charter and home
10 schools to scholarships, including tuition waivers, ~~which~~ THAT are issued
11 solely on the basis of academic merit and for which the universities
12 establish and administer fair and equitable selection criteria. The
13 universities under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of regents shall:

14 1. PUBLISH AND DISCLOSE TO APPLICANTS WHO APPLY FOR ADMISSION FROM
15 PUBLIC, PRIVATE, CHARTER AND HOME SCHOOLS THE MINIMUM TEST SCORES FOR
16 SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY.

17 2. NOTIFY STUDENTS IN THIS STATE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS IN A TIMELY
18 MANNER WITHOUT REGARD TO WHETHER THE STUDENTS ARE FROM PUBLIC, PRIVATE,
19 CHARTER OR HOME SCHOOLS.

20 3. ANNUALLY PUBLISH THE CRITERIA AND POLICIES REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION
21 AND report annually to the board information including the number of such
22 scholarships issued on the basis of academic merit to students from public,
23 private, charter and home schools.
