1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article XXXI, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be added as
4 follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the Governor:

5 ARTICLE XXXI. HUMAN CLONING

6 1. Human cloning

7 SECTION 1. HUMAN CLONING IN ANY FORM IS PROHIBITED IN
8 THIS STATE.

9 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
10 at the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of
11 Arizona.
