AN ACT

ENACTING AND ORDERING THE SUBMISSION TO THE PEOPLE OF A MEASURE RELATING TO
EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND HEALTH PROGRAMS.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona, the
2 Senate concurring:

3 1. Under the power of the referendum, as vested in the Legislature,
4 the following measure, relating to early childhood development and health
5 programs, is enacted to become valid as a law if approved by the voters and
6 on proclamation of the Governor:

7 AN ACT

8 REPEALING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 13, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;
9 AMENDING SECTION 42-3372, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO
10 EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT AND HEALTH PROGRAMS.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

12 Section 1. Termination and repeal

13 A. The Arizona early childhood development and health
14 board terminates on December 1, 2010 as provided by section
15 41-2956, Arizona Revised Statutes.

16 B. Title 8, chapter 13, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
17 repealed on June 1, 2011.

18 Sec. 2. Section 42-3372, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
19 amended to read:

20 42-3372. Disposition of monies

21 ~~Notwithstanding section 42-3102,~~ The department shall
22 deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147, monies levied
23 and collected pursuant to this article in the ~~early childhood~~
24 ~~development and education fund established by section 8-1181 for~~
25 ~~use as prescribed by title 8, chapter 13~~ STATE GENERAL FUND.
26 THESE MONIES SHALL BE SEPARATELY ACCOUNTED FOR AND SHALL BE
27 APPROPRIATED FOR HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR CHILDREN.

28 Sec. 3. Reversion of monies

29 On December 1, 2010, the remaining balance of unexpended
30 and unencumbered monies in the early childhood development and
31 health fund reverts to the state general fund.

32 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
33 at the next general election as provided by article IV, part 1, section 1,
34 Constitution of Arizona.
