10 compensation on a contingent basis.
11 ~~2. Lobby the legislature for compensation within one year after the~~
12 ~~person ceases to be a member of the senate or house of representatives.~~
13 ~~3.~~ 2. In any manner improperly seek to influence the vote of any
14 member of the legislature through communication with that member's employer.
