AMENDING SECTION 4-119, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

2 Section 1. Section 4-119, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 4-119. Records

5 A licensee shall keep records of licensed business activity in a manner
6 and location and for such duration as prescribed by the director. The rules
7 of the director shall require that each on-sale retailer maintain at the
8 licensed premises ALL REQUIRED RECORDS, INCLUDING a current log of all
9 persons employed at the licensed premises including each employee's full
10 legal name, date and place of birth, address and responsibilities.
