SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1432

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 31-228, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 31-228. Procedure for discharge of prisoner; return of property;
5 furnishing money, clothing and transportation ticket;
6 allowing hair to grow before discharge; application
7 for a nonoperating identification license; release
8 date notification

9 A. When a prisoner is released conditionally on parole, community
10 supervision or probation if the court waived community supervision pursuant
11 to section 13-603 or is discharged from a facility of the state department of
12 corrections there shall be returned to the prisoner everything of value taken
13 ~~upon~~ ON commitment to the state department of corrections, or thereafter
14 received by the prisoner.

15 B. Except as provided in subsection ~~C~~ D of this section and in
16 addition to items returned pursuant to subsection A of this section, all
17 monies accumulated in a wage earning prisoner's dedicated discharge account
18 shall be furnished to every paroled or discharged prisoner not previously
19 paroled, released on community supervision, released on probation if the
20 court waived community supervision pursuant to section 13-603 or ~~is~~
21 discharged from the state department of corrections. Not less than fifty
22 dollars ~~in-cash~~ shall be furnished to each nonwage earning inmate not
23 previously paroled or discharged from the state department of corrections,
24 unless such prisoner has immediately available financial resources in excess
25 of two hundred fifty dollars. Except for prisoners who are committed to the
26 department as a condition of probation, if a wage earning prisoner has
27 accumulated less than fifty dollars in the prisoner's dedicated discharge
28 account, the monies accumulated in the account shall be furnished to the
29 prisoner ~~upon~~ ON the prisoner's parole or discharge, and the state department
30 of corrections shall furnish the difference ~~in-cash~~ up to fifty dollars. ~~THE~~
31 ~~DEPARTMENT SHALL FURNISH THE MONIES TO A PRISONER WHO IS RELEASED TO THE~~
32 ~~COMMUNITY ON A STORED VALUE CARD, SMART CARD OR OTHER INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE~~
33 ~~THAT ENABLES A PERSON TO OBTAIN GOODS, SERVICES OR ANYTHING ELSE OF VALUE~~
34 ~~THROUGH THE USE OF VALUE STORED ON THE INSTRUMENT OR DEVICE.~~

1 C. A paroled prisoner, a prisoner who is released on community
2 supervision or probation if the court waived community supervision pursuant
3 to section 13-603 or a prisoner who is discharged may be furnished a
4 nontransferable ticket on a railroad or bus serving at or near the place of
5 release to the first railroad, bus station or ticket office beyond the limits
6 of the state in any direction. If the ticket is not used within three days
7 after the date of discharge, unless prevented by illness, it shall be void.

8 ~~C.~~ D. Notwithstanding subsection B of this section, the department
9 shall furnish clothing AND SHOES not exceeding thirty-five dollars in cost to
10 each prisoner who is paroled, discharged, released on community supervision
11 or released on probation if the court waived community supervision pursuant
12 to section 13-603.

13 ~~D.~~ E. One month ~~prior to~~ BEFORE the date of discharge, the prisoner
14 shall be permitted to allow the prisoner's hair to grow.

15 F. BEFORE A PRISONER IS RELEASED AND ON THE PRISONER'S REQUEST, THE
16 STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS SHALL FACILITATE A PRISONER'S APPLICATION TO
17 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE
18 ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-3165. ON THE PRISONER'S RELEASE, THE STATE
19 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS SHALL PROVIDE THE NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION
20 LICENSE TO THE PRISONER. THE PRISONER SHALL PAY THE FEE FOR A NONOPERATING
21 IDENTIFICATION LICENSE.

22 G. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY A PRISONER OF THE PRISONER'S RELEASE
23 DATE AT LEAST FORTY-EIGHT HOURS BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT RELEASES THE PRISONER.
24 FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT TO
25 EXTEND THE PRISONER'S RELEASE DATE."
