HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO H.B. 2466

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 42-6001, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 42-6001. Collection and administration of transaction privilege
5 tax and affiliated excise taxes; coordinated
6 licensing, collection and audit functions; fee

7 A. The department may collect and administer any transaction privilege
8 and affiliated excise taxes, including use tax, severance tax, jet fuel
9 excise and use tax, and rental occupancy tax, imposed by any city or town,
10 and the department and any city or town may enter into intergovernmental
11 contracts or agreements to provide a uniform method of administration,
12 collection, audit and licensing of transaction privilege and affiliated
13 excise taxes imposed by the state or cities or towns pursuant to title 11,
14 chapter 7, article 3.

15 B. The director may enter into agreements with cities and towns of
16 this state that levy transaction privilege and affiliated excise taxes to
17 provide for unified or coordinated licensing, collection and auditing
18 programs for such taxes levied by cities and towns and taxes levied pursuant
19 to chapter 5 of this title. Such cities and towns may enter into agreements
20 with the department to provide for unified or coordinated licensing,
21 collection and auditing programs for such transaction privilege and
22 affiliated excise taxes levied by such cities and towns and for taxes levied
23 pursuant to chapter 5 of this title.

24 C. A city or town that does not enter into an agreement with the
25 department for the collection of municipal transaction privilege and
26 affiliated excise taxes shall report to the department on or before September
27 1 of each year the total amount of those taxes collected by the city or town
28 in the preceding fiscal year.

29 D. The director shall establish with such cities and towns a uniform
30 licensing, collection and audit committee to direct such unified or
31 coordinated functions.

32 E. IF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE HAS NOT ENTERED INTO AN
33 INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT WITH A CITY OR TOWN UNDER SUBSECTION
34 B OF THIS SECTION TO PROVIDE A COORDINATED METHOD OF COLLECTING TRANSACTION
35 PRIVILEGE AND AFFILIATED EXCISE TAXES, A TAXPAYER WHO IS REQUIRED TO PAY ANY
36 TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE AND AFFILIATED EXCISE TAXES TO A CITY OR TOWN MAY

1 INSTEAD PAY THE REQUIRED TAX THROUGH AN ONLINE PORTAL MAINTAINED BY THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION. THE ONLINE PORTAL SHALL BE PROCURED BY THE
3 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION PURSUANT TO A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP ENTERED
4 INTO PURSUANT TO SECTION 41-2559, SHALL INCLUDE ACCESS TO A SINGLE POINT OF
5 FILING AND SHALL PROVIDE SECURITY MEASURES TO PROTECT TAXPAYER INFORMATION.
6 THE TAXPAYER MAY BE CHARGED A FEE TO USE THE ONLINE PORTAL.

7 Sec. 2. Collection of municipal transaction privilege taxes;
8 online portal; department of administration; request
9 for proposals; delayed repeal

10 A. After consultation with the department of revenue, the department
11 of administration shall issue a request for proposals for implementation of
12 an online portal to allow taxpayers to remit the transaction privilege and
13 affiliated excise taxes levied by the city or town as provided by section
14 42-6001, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act. The initial costs
15 of implementing the online portal shall be paid by the vendor.

16 B. At least fifty per cent of the members of the selection committee
17 appointed for the procurement required by this section shall be persons
18 nominated to the selection committee by a statewide association of cities and
19 towns.

20 C. Notwithstanding title 41, chapter 23, Arizona Revised Statutes, the
21 procurement required by this section shall be completed, and a contract
22 awarded pursuant to section 41-2559, Arizona Revised Statutes, on or before
23 October 1, 2013. The online portal shall be fully operational on or before
24 January 1, 2015.

25 D. This section is repealed from and after June 30, 2015."
