AMENDING SECTION 26-121, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA
STATE GUARD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 26-121, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 ~~26-121.~~ Composition of militia: persons exempt

5 The militia of the state of Arizona consists of all able-bodied
6 citizens of the state ~~between the ages of eighteen and forty-five years~~ WHO
7 ARE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND CAPABLE OF BEARING ARMS and all
8 residents of the state ~~between such ages~~ WHO ARE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF
9 AGE, WHO ARE CAPABLE OF BEARING ARMS AND who have declared their intention to
10 become citizens of the United States, except:

11 1. Persons exempted by the laws of the state or the United States.

12 2. Idiots, lunatics, totally blind persons and persons convicted of
13 infamous crimes.

14 3. Judges and clerks of courts of record.

15 4. State and county civil officers holding office by election, and
16 members of the legislature.

17 5. Ministers of the gospel.
