AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 37, CHAPTER 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 20;
AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING
SECTION 41-3024.01; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 37, chapter 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding article 20, to read:

4 ARTICLE 20. ARIZONA RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL

6 duties: report

7 A. THE ARIZONA RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF
8 THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

9 1. THREE PERSONS WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, ONE OF WHOM IS A
10 MEMBER OF THE FEDERAL RESOURCE ADVISORY COUNCIL AND WHO EITHER:

11 (a) HOLDS A FEDERAL GRAZING PERMIT OR LEASE WITHIN THIS STATE.

12 (b) REPRESENTS INTERESTS ASSOCIATED WITH TRANSPORTATION OR
13 RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

14 (c) REPRESENTS THE COMMERCIAL TIMBER INDUSTRY.

15 (d) REPRESENTS THE MINERAL OR ENERGY DEVELOPMENT INDUSTRY.

16 2. ONE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND WHO EITHER:

17 (a) REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED ENVIRONMENTAL OR
18 CONSERVATION ORGANIZATION.

19 (b) REPRESENTS DISPERSED RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY INTERESTS.

20 (c) REPRESENTS ARCHAEOLOGICAL OR HISTORICAL INTERESTS.

21 (d) REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED WILD HORSE AND
22 BURRO INTEREST GROUP.

23 3. A PERSON WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE LAND DEPARTMENT OR THE
24 DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

25 4. ONE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND WHO
26 EITHER:

27 (a) HOLDS A FEDERAL GRAZING PERMIT OR LEASE WITHIN THIS STATE.

28 (b) REPRESENTS INTERESTS ASSOCIATED WITH TRANSPORTATION OR
29 RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

30 (c) REPRESENTS THE COMMERCIAL TIMBER INDUSTRY.

31 (d) REPRESENTS THE MINERAL OR ENERGY DEVELOPMENT INDUSTRY.

32 5. ONE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND WHO
33 EITHER:

34 (a) REPRESENTS DISPERSED RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY INTERESTS.

35 (b) REPRESENTS ARCHAEOLOGICAL OR HISTORICAL INTERESTS.

36 (c) REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED WILD HORSE AND
37 BURRO INTEREST GROUP.

38 6. ONE PERSON WHO REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED
39 ENVIRONMENTAL OR CONSERVATION ORGANIZATION AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE
40 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

41 7. ONE PERSON WHO HOLDS STATE, COUNTY OR LOCAL ELECTED OFFICE AND WHO
42 IS APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

43 8. ONE PERSON WHO IS A PROFESSOR AT A UNIVERSITY IN THIS STATE, WHO
44 SPECIALIZES IN NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT OR NATURAL SCIENCES AND WHO IS
45 APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

1 9. ONE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
2 REPRESENTATIVES AND WHO EITHER:

3 (a) HOLDS A FEDERAL GRAZING PERMIT OR LEASE WITHIN THIS STATE.

4 (b) REPRESENTS INTERESTS ASSOCIATED WITH TRANSPORTATION OR
5 RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

6 (c) REPRESENTS THE COMMERCIAL TIMBER INDUSTRY.

7 (d) REPRESENTS THE MINERAL OR ENERGY DEVELOPMENT INDUSTRY.

8 10. ONE PERSON WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
9 REPRESENTATIVES AND WHO EITHER:

10 (a) REPRESENTS DISPERSED RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY INTERESTS.

11 (b) REPRESENTS ARCHAEOLOGICAL OR HISTORICAL INTERESTS.

12 (c) REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED WILD HORSE AND
13 BURRO INTEREST GROUP.

14 11. ONE PERSON WHO REPRESENTS A NATIONALLY OR REGIONALLY RECOGNIZED
15 ENVIRONMENTAL OR CONSERVATION ORGANIZATION AND WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE
16 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

17 12. ONE PERSON WHO REPRESENTS INDIAN TRIBES IN THIS STATE AND WHO IS
18 APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

19 13. A PUBLIC MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES.

21 B. THE COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON AND VICE-CHAIRPERSON FROM
22 AMONG ITS MEMBERS. THE COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A NEW CHAIRPERSON AND
23 VICE-CHAIRPERSON EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

24 C. THE INITIAL COUNCIL MEMBERS SHALL ASSIGN THEMSELVES BY LOT TO TERMS
25 OF ONE, TWO AND THREE YEARS IN OFFICE. ALL SUBSEQUENT MEMBERS SERVE
26 THREE-YEAR TERMS. THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL NOTIFY THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY ON
27 APPOINTMENT OF THESE TERMS.

28 D. COUNCIL MEMBERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT ARE
29 ELIGIBLE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES PURSUANT TO TITLE 38, CHAPTER 4,
30 ARTICLE 2.

31 E. A COUNCIL MEMBER SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY SPECIFIC MATTER,
32 INCLUDING A LEASE, LICENSE, PERMIT, CONTRACT, CLAIM, AGREEMENT OR RELATED
33 LITIGATION WITH THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, IN WHICH THE
34 MEMBER HAS A DIRECT FINANCIAL INTEREST.

35 F. THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE COUNCIL MAY FORM SUBCOMMITTEES FOR THE
36 PURPOSE OF COMPILING INFORMATION OR CONDUCTING RESEARCH. A SUBCOMMITTEE
37 SHALL REPORT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE FULL COUNCIL FOR CONSIDERATION.

38 G. THE COUNCIL SHALL:

39 1. ACT AS AN ADVISORY BODY REGARDING THE PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT OF
40 FEDERAL LAND RESOURCES IN THIS STATE.

41 2. DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS FOR:

42 (a) THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT AND ANY OTHER FEDERAL
43 LAND MANAGEMENT AGENCY, AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNCIL, REGARDING LAND USE
44 PLANNING, CLASSIFICATION AND RETENTION AND THE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL OF
45 FEDERAL LANDS WITHIN THIS STATE.

1 (b) ANY OTHER MATTER ON REQUEST OF THE GOVERNOR, PRESIDENT OF THE
2 SENATE, SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR STATE LAND COMMISSIONER.

3 3. SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE
4 GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 AND PROVIDE A COPY OF THIS REPORT TO
6 THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

13 Sec. 3. Purpose

14 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection E, Arizona Revised Statutes,
15 the legislature establishes the Arizona resource advisory council to advise
16 the United States bureau of land management and other federal land management
17 agencies on the planning and management of federal land resources in this
18 state.
