

## HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1069**

Coleman Floor Amendment

---

SB 1069, as amended by the committee on County and Municipal Affairs, prohibits municipalities and counties from adopting ordinances or resolutions that require retail businesses to comply with specific security requirements. This bill as amended stipulates that retail businesses for the purposes of this Act do not include any businesses that serve alcohol, dispense or cultivate medical marijuana, require age verification for admittance, or businesses that provide live entertainment.

Your 17-line substitute floor amendment to the CMA committee amendment excludes bars and hotels from classification as retail businesses for the purposes of this Act and removes language regarding businesses that serve alcohol. The amendment clarifies that the Legislature finds the imposition of security requirements on retail businesses, in a uniform and consistent manner, as a matter of statewide concern. It makes other technical changes.
