

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1200**

Pratt Floor Amendment

The substitute floor amendment to the Energy, Environment and Natural Resources Committee amendment to SB 1200 makes the following changes:

1. Specifies that monies in the Mining, Mineral and Natural Resources Educational Museum (Museum) account (Account) are to be used exclusively for the maintenance, restoration and operations of the museum;
2. Requires the Arizona Geological Survey (AGS) to adopt a collections management policy established by a national association of museums;
3. Allows AGS to sell or otherwise dispose of materials received for the Museum in coordination with the Museum Advisory Council and pursuant to AGS adopted national museum standards and best practices; and
4. Requires all unexpended and unencumbered monies received by the Historical Society for operating the former museum, including monies from the gift shop and any entrance fees collected are transferred to the Museum Account.
