1 Page 66, after line 13, insert:

2 "Sec. 20. Laws 2015, chapter 10, section 21 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 21. Legislative intent

4 A. It is the intent of the legislature that the fees prescribed in
5 section 42-5041, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes, be assessed and
6 collected pursuant to the following guidelines:

7 1. The total fees for all counties, cities and towns may not exceed
8 \$20,755,835 in any fiscal year.

9 2. The share of fees assessed to all counties pursuant to paragraph 1
10 of this subsection shall be in proportion to the aggregate amount of monies
11 distributed to counties ~~in the preceding two fiscal years~~ FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
12 TWO YEARS PRECEDING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR pursuant to title 42, chapter 6,
13 article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, and section 42-5029, Arizona Revised
14 Statutes, as a percentage of aggregate distributions to all counties, cities
15 and towns ~~in the preceding two fiscal years~~ FOR THE FISCAL YEAR TWO YEARS
16 PRECEDING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR pursuant to title 42, chapter 6, article 3,
17 Arizona Revised Statutes, and sections 42-5029, 42-6001 and 43-206, Arizona
18 Revised Statutes.

19 3. The share of fees assessed to all cities and towns pursuant to
20 paragraph 1 of this subsection shall be in proportion to the aggregate amount
21 of monies distributed to cities and towns ~~in the preceding two fiscal years~~
22 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR TWO YEARS PRECEDING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR pursuant to
23 ~~title 42, chapter 6, article 3, Arizona Revised Statutes, and section~~
24 SECTIONS 42-5029, 42-6001 AND 43-206, Arizona Revised Statutes, as a
25 percentage of aggregate distributions to all counties, cities and towns ~~in~~
26 ~~the preceding two fiscal years~~ FOR THE FISCAL YEAR TWO YEARS PRECEDING THE
27 CURRENT FISCAL YEAR pursuant to title 42, chapter 6, article 3, Arizona
28 Revised Statutes, and sections 42-5029, 42-6001 and 43-206, Arizona Revised
29 Statutes.

1 4. Except as provided by sections 42-5033 and 42-5033.01, Arizona
2 Revised Statutes, the population of a county as determined by the most recent
3 United States decennial census plus any revision to the decennial census
4 certified by the United States census bureau shall be used as the basis for
5 apportioning monies pursuant to paragraph 2 of this subsection.

6 5. Except as provided by sections 42-5033 and 42-5033.01, Arizona
7 Revised Statutes, the population of a city or town as determined by the most
8 recent United States decennial census plus any revision to the decennial
9 census certified by the United States census bureau shall be used as the
10 basis for apportioning monies pursuant to paragraph 3 of this subsection.

11 B. It is the intent of the legislature that the fees prescribed in
12 section 42-5041, subsection C, Arizona Revised Statutes, be payable in an
13 amount equal to seventy-six cents multiplied by the population of the city or
14 town used for the purposes of computing state share revenues pursuant to
15 sections 42-5029 and 43-206, Arizona Revised Statutes."
