


HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1461**

Lawrence Floor Amendment

As passed by the Committee on Education, SB 1461 creates an exemption for Move on When Reading competency requirements for students with a speech and language impairment or significant reading impairment.

Your 6-line Floor Amendment to SB 1461 makes the following changes:

- Creates an exemption for students in the process of a special education referral or evaluation for placement in special education.
- Removes the requirement that a parent submit a written request for an exemption for dyslexia to a school district governing board or charter school.
- Removes the requirement that a school district or charter school provide evidence-based reading support services and assistance to a student issued an exemption for dyslexia.
