## FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

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The strike-everything amendment to HB 2036 makes changes to the license by endorsement and examination statutes for naturopathic physicians.

The floor amendment *requires* rather than *allows* a person applying for a license by endorsement to take and pass the clinical elective examinations of minor surgery and acupuncture if the person is applying for a license that includes those elective practice areas.

Adds clarifying language into the retired licensee and reinstatement of license statutes that the applicant must present evidence satisfactory to the Board that the applicant is professionally able to engage or assist in the practice of naturopathic medicine and possesses the professional knowledge required.

15 A. A person whose license, certificate or registration has been  
16 suspended for an indefinite period of time or revoked by the board may apply  
17 to the board for the termination of the suspension or reissuance of the  
18 revoked license, certificate or registration under the following terms and  
19 conditions:

20 1. The application ~~shall be~~ HAS BEEN submitted in writing, ~~shall be~~  
21 HAS BEEN verified under oath and ~~shall contain~~ CONTAINS or ~~have~~ HAS attached  
22 to it substantial evidence showing that the basis for suspension or  
23 revocation has been removed and that the termination of the suspension or

1 reissuance of the revoked license, certificate or registration will not  
2 constitute a threat to the public health or safety.

3 2. THE APPLICANT HAS PAID THE APPLICATION FEE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION  
4 32-1527 AND, IF REQUESTED BY THE BOARD, HAS PRESENTED EVIDENCE SATISFACTORY  
5 TO THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT IS PROFESSIONALLY ABLE TO ENGAGE OR ASSIST IN  
6 THE PRACTICE OF NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE AND POSSESSES THE PROFESSIONAL  
7 KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED.

8 ~~2.~~ 3. If it is an application for the termination of a suspension for  
9 an indefinite period, the applicant has not applied for termination more  
10 frequently than once in any six-month period.

11 ~~3.~~ 4. If it is an application for the reissuance of a revoked  
12 license, certificate or registration, the applicant has not applied for  
13 reissuance more frequently than once in any twenty-four-month period.

14 B. The board may interview an applicant under subsection A OF THIS  
15 SECTION.

16 C. The board shall make its determination on each application as it  
17 deems consistent with the public health and safety and just in the  
18 circumstances."
