Bill Number: **HB 2368**

Thorpe Floor Amendment

HB 2368 prohibits the state from funding executive orders issued by the President of the United States and policy directives from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) unless affirmed by a vote of Congress and signed into law as prescribed by the U.S. Constitution.

Your 11 line floor amendment to HB 2368 makes the following changes:

- Adds that the prohibition may be waived by a vote of the Legislature if in session or by the Governor, President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House if not in session.
