3 is amended by adding sections 15-701.02, 15-701.03, 15-701.04, 15-701.05,
4 15-701.06 and 15-701.07, to read:

5 15-701.02. Arizona education standards and assessments; notice;
6 public meetings; adoption; student and teacher
7 information privacy

8 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY NOT
9 ADOPT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY NOT IMPLEMENT THE COMMON CORE
10 STANDARDS, THIS STATE'S COLLEGE AND CAREER READY STANDARDS OR ANY OTHER
11 STANDARDS OR ASSESSMENTS FROM ANY THIRD-PARTY PROVIDER THAT ARE ALIGNED WITH
12 STANDARDS OR ASSESSMENTS PROPOSED BY THE PARTNERSHIP FOR ASSESSMENT OF
13 READINESS FOR COLLEGE AND CAREERS OR THAT ARE THE SAME AS OR SUBSTANTIALLY
14 SIMILAR TO STANDARDS OR ASSESSMENTS USED BY TWENTY OR MORE OTHER STATES. ANY
15 ACTIONS THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY TAKEN TO ADOPT OR IMPLEMENT STANDARDS OR
16 ASSESSMENTS THAT CONFLICT WITH THIS SECTION ARE VOID ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
17 THIS SECTION.

18 B. THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY
19 SECTION 15-701.05, SHALL ADOPT AND THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL
20 ADMINISTER THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS FOR THIS STATE'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
21 AN OFFICIAL OF THIS STATE, WHETHER APPOINTED OR ELECTED, MAY NOT JOIN ANY
22 CONSORTIUM, ASSOCIATION OR OTHER ENTITY ON BEHALF OF THIS STATE OR A STATE
23 AGENCY IF THE MEMBERSHIP WOULD REQUIRE THIS STATE TO CEDE ANY MEASURE OF
24 CONTROL OVER EDUCATION, INCLUDING ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS AND ASSESSMENTS
25 OF THOSE STANDARDS.

26 C. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA
27 EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE OF ANY
28 PROPOSED ADOPTION OR REVISION OF ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS ON THE DEPARTMENT
29 OF EDUCATION'S WEBSITE. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH
30 THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL REQUEST COMMENTS ON
31 THE PROPOSED CHANGES FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC, INCLUDING PARENTS, TEACHERS,
32 EXPERTS ON ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF POLITICAL
33 ORGANIZATIONS, EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND
34 NONPARTISAN POLICY ORGANIZATIONS. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN
35 COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL
36 ACCEPT ALL PUBLIC COMMENTS THAT ARE SUBMITTED WITHIN SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE
37 PUBLIC NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBSECTION.

38 D. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA
39 EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, MAY NOT ADOPT OR REVISE ANY STATEWIDE
40 ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS UNTIL PUBLIC MEETINGS ARE HELD IN EACH
41 CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT IN THIS STATE. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL
42 POST NOTICE OF EACH PUBLIC MEETING ON THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S WEBSITE
43 AND IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE RESPECTIVE CONGRESSIONAL
44 DISTRICT.

1 E. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC
2 INSTRUCTION, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND
3 ANY OTHER STATE ENTITY THAT DEALS WITH EDUCATION MAY NOT DO ANY OF THE
4 FOLLOWING:

5 1. SPEND ANY MONIES ON THE CONSTRUCTION, ENHANCEMENT OR EXPANSION OF
6 ANY STATEWIDE LONGITUDINAL DATA SYSTEM DESIGNED TO TRACK STUDENTS OR COMPILE
7 PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE STUDENT INFORMATION, UNLESS THE EXPENDITURE IS
8 NECESSARY FOR BASIC ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES, FOR ACADEMIC EVALUATION OF
9 PROGRAMS AND STUDENT PROGRESS OR FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

10 2. SHARE ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS OR
11 TEACHERS WITH ANY ENTITY OUTSIDE THIS STATE, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS
12 SECTION. THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO VIRTUAL FILE STORAGE, ONLINE FILE
13 STORAGE OR HARD DRIVE FILE STORAGE THAT IS HOSTED BY THIRD PARTIES OUTSIDE OF
14 THIS STATE.

15 3. SHARE ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS OR
16 TEACHERS WITH ANY ENTITY THAT INTENDS TO USE THAT INFORMATION TO DEVELOP
17 COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS OR SERVICES OR THAT INTENDS TO TRANSFER THE INFORMATION
18 TO ANY OTHER ENTITY FOR USE IN DEVELOPING COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS OR SERVICES.

19 4. SHARE ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS OR
20 TEACHERS WITH ANY ENTITY WITHIN THIS STATE, UNLESS THAT ENTITY IS AN
21 EDUCATIONAL AGENCY OR AN INSTITUTION THAT THIS STATE EXPRESSLY PROHIBITS, IN
22 WRITING, FROM DOING BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

23 (a) USING THE INFORMATION TO DEVELOP COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS OR SERVICES
24 OR TRANSFERRING THE INFORMATION TO ANY OTHER ENTITY TO DEVELOP COMMERCIAL
25 PRODUCTS OR SERVICES.

26 (b) USING THE TRANSFER OF INFORMATION FOR ECONOMIC OR WORKFORCE
27 DEVELOPMENT PLANNING.

28 5. SHARE ANY PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS OR
29 TEACHERS WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, UNLESS ALL OF THE
30 FOLLOWING APPLY:

31 (a) THE SHARING OF INFORMATION IS REQUIRED AS A CONDITION OF RECEIVING
32 A FEDERAL EDUCATION GRANT.

33 (b) THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AGREES, IN WRITING, TO
34 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

35 (i) TO USE THE INFORMATION ONLY TO EVALUATE THE PROGRAM OR PROGRAMS
36 FUNDED BY THE GRANT.

37 (ii) TO NOT USE THE INFORMATION FOR ANY RESEARCH EXCEPT AS RELATED TO
38 THE EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAM OR PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE GRANT, UNLESS THE
39 TEACHER OR THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF ANY STUDENT WHOSE INFORMATION WILL BE
40 USED FOR THE RESEARCH AFFIRMATIVELY CONSENTS TO THAT USE IN WRITING.

41 (iii) TO NOT SHARE THE INFORMATION WITH ANY OTHER GOVERNMENTAL OR
42 PRIVATE ENTITY, UNLESS THE TEACHER OR THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF ANY STUDENT
43 WHOSE INFORMATION WILL BE SHARED AFFIRMATIVELY CONSENTS TO THAT SHARING IN
44 WRITING.

45 (iv) TO DESTROY THE INFORMATION ON COMPLETION OF THE EVALUATION OF THE
46 PROGRAM OR PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE GRANT.

47 (c) THE GRANT OR PROGRAM FOR WHICH THE INFORMATION IS REQUIRED IS
48 AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL LAW.

1 F. IF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REQUIRES AS A
2 CONDITION OF A FEDERAL EDUCATION GRANT THAT THE GRANT RECIPIENT PROVIDE
3 PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION OF STUDENTS OR TEACHERS IN A WAY THAT
4 DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION, THE GRANT RECIPIENT SHALL NOTIFY THE
5 TEACHER OR THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF ANY STUDENT WHOSE INFORMATION IS
6 REQUIRED OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

7 1. THAT THE GRANT RECIPIENT HAS BEEN REQUIRED TO TURN OVER THE
8 TEACHER'S OR STUDENT'S INFORMATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
9 EDUCATION.

10 2. THAT NEITHER THE GRANT RECIPIENT NOR ANY OTHER ENTITY OR OFFICIAL
11 WITHIN THIS STATE WILL HAVE CONTROL OF THE USE OR FURTHER SHARING OF THAT
12 INFORMATION.

13 3. THE CONTACT INFORMATION, INCLUDING THE TELEPHONE NUMBER AND E-MAIL
14 ADDRESS, OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OFFICIAL WHO IS SEEKING
15 THE INFORMATION.

19 A. BEGINNING WITH THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR, THE STATE BOARD OF
20 EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING
21 COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 15-701.05, SHALL ADOPT AREAS OF SUBJECT
22 MATTER STANDARDS THAT ARE SUBJECT TO LEGISLATIVE REVIEW AND APPROVAL PURSUANT
23 TO SECTION 15-701.06. THE SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED
24 STATEWIDE BY EVERY PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THIS STATE. ANY REVISIONS ADOPTED BY THE
25 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION
26 STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, ARE SUBJECT TO LEGISLATIVE REVIEW AND APPROVAL
27 PURSUANT TO SECTION 15-701.06.

28 B. IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS
29 SECTION, ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2017, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN
30 COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE AND IN
31 CONSULTATION WITH THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, SHALL ADOPT SUBJECT MATTER
32 STANDARDS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND
33 MATHEMATICS THAT WILL REPLACE THE PREVIOUS STANDARDS. THE STANDARDS SHALL BE
34 EVALUATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS AND
35 ADDRESS THE GOALS OF REDUCING THE NEED FOR REMEDIAL COURSEWORK AT THE
36 POSTSECONDARY LEVEL AND INCREASING THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF POSTSECONDARY
37 EDUCATION. THE SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND CORRESPONDING STATEWIDE STUDENT
38 ASSESSMENTS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND
39 MATHEMATICS SHALL BE APPROVED AND CONTROLLED SOLELY BY THIS STATE THROUGH THE
40 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

41 C. ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD OF
42 EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING
43 COMMITTEE, SHALL BEGIN THE PROCESS OF ADOPTING THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS,
44 AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS STANDARDS AND SHALL PROVIDE
45 REASONABLE OPPORTUNITY, CONSISTENT WITH BEST PRACTICES, FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON
46 THE REVISION OF THE STANDARDS, INCLUDING COMMENTS FROM STUDENTS, PARENTS,
47 EDUCATORS, ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTING STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AND ENGLISH
48 LANGUAGE LEARNERS, HIGHER EDUCATION REPRESENTATIVES, CAREER TECHNOLOGY

1 EDUCATION REPRESENTATIVES, SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS, COMMUNITY-BASED
2 ORGANIZATIONS, NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL REPRESENTATIVES AND BUSINESS COMMUNITY
3 REPRESENTATIVES.

4 D. UNTIL THE STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS,
5 AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS ARE IMPLEMENTED, THE STATE BOARD OF
6 EDUCATION SHALL IMPLEMENT THE STANDARDS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN
7 HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THAT WERE IN PLACE ON MAY 31, 2010.

8 E. ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION
9 SHALL SEEK CERTIFICATION FROM THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS THAT THE SUBJECT
10 MATTER STANDARDS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND
11 MATHEMATICS THAT WERE IN PLACE ON MAY 31, 2010 ARE COLLEGE AND CAREER READY
12 AS DEFINED IN THE FEDERAL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT FLEXIBILITY
13 DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND REFERENCED
14 IN OPTION B OF PRINCIPLE 1: COLLEGE AND CAREER-READY EXPECTATIONS FOR ALL
15 STUDENTS. THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL PROVIDE TO THE STATE BOARD OF
16 EDUCATION A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE CERTIFICATION PROCESS AND RESULTS,
17 INCLUDING A LIST OF DEFICIENCIES IF THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS CONCLUDES
18 THAT THE STANDARDS ARE NOT COLLEGE AND CAREER READY. THE STATE BOARD OF
19 EDUCATION SHALL POST ON THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S WEBSITE ALL DOCUMENTS,
20 MATERIALS, REPORTS, DESCRIPTIONS AND CORRESPONDENCE PRODUCED OR USED BY THE
21 ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS IN THE CERTIFICATION PROCESS.

22 F. ON OR BEFORE THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR, THE STATE BOARD OF
23 EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING
24 COMMITTEE AND IN CONSULTATION WITH ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, SHALL DIRECT THE
25 PROCESS OF DEVELOPING ANNUAL HIGH-QUALITY STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS FOR
26 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THAT ALIGN
27 WITH THE COLLEGE AND CAREER READY SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS ADOPTED PURSUANT
28 TO THIS SECTION.

29 G. THE STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS,
30 AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS SHALL CONTINUE TO ASSESS STANDARDS
31 AND OBJECTIVES FOUND IN THE SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE
32 ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THAT WERE IN PLACE ON MAY 31,
33 2010 AND SHALL CONTINUE TO ALIGN TO THE STANDARDS AND OBJECTIVES FOUND IN
34 THOSE SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS UNTIL THE REPLACEMENT ASSESSMENTS ARE
35 IMPLEMENTED.

36 H. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY NOT ENTER INTO ANY AGREEMENT,
37 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OR CONTRACT WITH ANY FEDERAL AGENCY OR PRIVATE
38 ENTITY THAT IN ANY WAY CEDES OR LIMITS STATE DISCRETION OR CONTROL OVER THE
39 PROCESS OF DEVELOPING, ADOPTING OR REVISING SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND
40 CORRESPONDING STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM,
41 INCLUDING AGREEMENTS, MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING AND CONTRACTS IN EXCHANGE
42 FOR FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND PROGRAMS. IF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION
43 IS A PARTY TO SUCH AN AGREEMENT, MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OR CONTRACT ON
44 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL
45 INITIATE NECESSARY EFFORTS TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT, MEMORANDUM OF
46 UNDERSTANDING OR CONTRACT TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

47 I. THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM
48 SEEKING AND BEING GRANTED A WAIVER FROM FEDERAL LAW IF THE CONDITIONS FOR THE

1 WAIVER DO NOT REQUIRE THIS STATE TO CEDE OR LIMIT ITS DISCRETION OR CONTROL
2 OVER THE PROCESS OF DEVELOPING, ADOPTING OR REVISING SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS
3 AND CORRESPONDING STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS.

4 J. THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY PARTICIPATE IN A MULTISTATE OR
5 MULTIGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE BUT MAY NOT BIND THIS STATE, CONTRACTUALLY OR
6 OTHERWISE, TO THE AUTHORITY OF ANY OTHER STATE, ORGANIZATION OR ENTITY THAT
7 SUPERSEDES THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

8 K. THE CONTENT OF ALL SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND CORRESPONDING
9 STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE APPROVED AND CONTROLLED SOLELY BY THIS
10 STATE THROUGH THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA
11 EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN
12 COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL
13 MAINTAIN INDEPENDENCE OF ALL SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND CORRESPONDING
14 STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS AND MAY NOT RELINQUISH AUTHORITY OVER THE
15 STANDARDS AND ASSESSMENTS. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT BENCHMARKING
16 THE STATE SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND CORRESPONDING STATEWIDE STUDENT
17 ASSESSMENTS WITH THOSE OF OTHER STATES OR NATIONS TO ALLOW COMPARISON OF THIS
18 STATE'S SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS AND CORRESPONDING STATEWIDE STUDENT
19 ASSESSMENTS WITH THOSE OF OTHER STATES AND NATIONS.

20 L. SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS SHALL DETERMINE THE
21 INSTRUCTION, CURRICULA, READING LISTS AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS AND
22 TEXTBOOKS, SUBJECT TO ANY APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OR REQUIREMENTS AS SET FORTH
23 IN LAW, TO BE USED IN MEETING THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS. SCHOOL
24 DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS MAY ADOPT SUPPLEMENTARY STUDENT ASSESSMENTS
25 THAT ARE IN ADDITION TO THE STATEWIDE STUDENT ASSESSMENTS.

26 M. ON THE ADOPTION OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN HISTORY, SCIENCE
27 AND MATHEMATICS SUBJECT MATTER STANDARDS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, THE STATE
28 BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS
29 STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL COMPARE THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, AMERICAN
30 HISTORY, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS STANDARDS WITH THOSE THAT WERE ADOPTED BY
31 THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION BEFORE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF
32 THIS SECTION. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL CONSIDER PUBLIC COMMENTS,
33 THE USE OF BEST PRACTICES, EVIDENCE AND RESEARCH IN THE EVALUATION OF BOTH
34 SETS OF STANDARDS. THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE
35 ARIZONA EDUCATION STANDARDS STEERING COMMITTEE, SHALL COMPARE THE STANDARDS
36 IN THE AREAS OF:

37 1. EFFECTIVE PREPARATION FOR ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP AND POSTSECONDARY
38 EDUCATION OR THE WORKFORCE.

39 2. SUBJECT MATTER CONTENT.
