**AMENDING SECTION 28-892, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES
AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-892, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-892. Riding on motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle

5 A person operating a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle shall ride only
6 on the permanent and regular seat attached to the motorcycle or all-terrain
7 vehicle. The operator of a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle shall not carry
8 any other person and any other person shall not ride on a motorcycle or
9 all-terrain vehicle unless the motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle is ~~designed~~
10 ~~EQUIPPED~~ to carry more than one person. On a motorcycle or all-terrain
11 vehicle ~~designed~~ **THAT IS EQUIPPED** to carry more than one person, a passenger
12 may ride on the permanent and regular seat if it is ~~designed~~ **EQUIPPED** for two
13 persons or on another seat firmly attached to the motorcycle or all-terrain
14 vehicle at the rear or side of the operator.
