AMENDING SECTION 41-1051, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
GOVERNOR'S REGULATORY REVIEW COUNCIL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-1051, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-1051. Governor's regulatory review council: membership:
5 terms: compensation: powers

6 A. ~~A~~ THE governor's regulatory review council is established ~~that~~
7 ~~consists~~ CONSISTING of ~~six~~ SEVEN members who are appointed by the governor
8 pursuant to section 38-211, ~~and~~ the director of the department of
9 administration or the assistant director of the department of administration
10 who is responsible for administering the council. The director or assistant
11 director is an ex officio member and chairperson of the council. The council
12 shall elect a vice-chairperson to serve as chairperson in the chairperson's
13 absence. The governor shall appoint at least one member who represents the
14 public interest, at least one member who represents the business community,
15 AT LEAST ONE MEMBER WHO IS A SMALL BUSINESS OWNER, one member from a list of
16 three persons who are not legislators submitted by the president of the
17 senate and one member from a list of three persons who are not legislators
18 submitted by the speaker of the house of representatives. At least one
19 member of the council shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in this
20 state. The governor shall appoint the members of the council for staggered
21 terms of three years. A vacancy occurring during the term of office of any
22 member shall be filled by appointment by the governor for the unexpired
23 portion of the term in the same manner as provided in this section.

24 B. The council shall meet at least once a month at a time and place
25 set by the chairperson and at other times and places as the chairperson deems
26 necessary.

27 C. Members of the council are eligible to receive compensation in an
28 amount of two hundred dollars for each day on which the council meets and
29 reimbursement of expenses pursuant to title 38, chapter 4, article 2.

30 D. The chairperson, subject to chapter 4, article 4 and, as
31 applicable, articles 5 and 6 of this title, shall employ, determine the
32 conditions of employment of and specify the duties of administrative,
33 secretarial and clerical employees as the chairperson deems necessary.

34 E. The council may make rules pursuant to this chapter to carry out
35 the purposes of this chapter.

36 F. The council shall make a list of agency rules approved or returned
37 pursuant to sections 41-1027 and 41-1052 and section 41-1056, subsection C
38 for the previous twelve-month period available to the public on request and
39 on the council's website.
