AN ACT

**AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING
SECTION 9-500.38; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL SERVICES.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 9, chapter 4, article 8, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 9-500.38, to read:

4 9-500.38. Municipal service access cards; requirements;
5 prohibitions; applicability

6 A. A CITY OR TOWN MAY ISSUE A MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD TO AN
7 INDIVIDUAL TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO MUNICIPAL SERVICES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS
8 ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FROM THE CITY OR TOWN. A CITY OR TOWN THAT ISSUES A
9 MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD SHALL:

10 1. LABEL THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD, IN AT LEAST TWELVE-POINT
11 BOLD-FACED TYPE, "FOR USE TO ACCESS MUNICIPAL SERVICES ONLY, NOT AN
12 IDENTIFICATION CARD".

13 2. LIST ON THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD ONLY THE SERVICES THAT
14 THE INDIVIDUAL TO WHOM THE CARD IS ISSUED IS LEGALLY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE.

15 3. NOT CONTAIN THE WORD "IDENTIFICATION", EXCEPT TO STATE THAT THE
16 MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD IS NOT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.

17 B. A CITY OR TOWN MAY ISSUE A MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD THAT IS
18 ALSO AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO ACCESS MUNICIPAL SERVICES
19 THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FROM THE CITY OR TOWN. A CITY OR
20 TOWN THAT ISSUES A MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD THAT IS ALSO AN
21 IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL:

22 1. ADOPT PROCEDURES THAT ARE AT LEAST AS STRINGENT AS THE PROCEDURES
23 ADOPTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR
24 ISSUING A NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE.

25 2. REQUIRE THE INDIVIDUAL TO SUBMIT THE SAME INFORMATION NECESSARY TO
26 OBTAIN A NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-3165,
27 SUBSECTION F.

28 3. ACCEPT ONLY THE DOCUMENTS APPROVED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION OF
29 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF IDENTITY.

30 C. A MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARD ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION MAY
31 NOT HAVE THE SAME COLOR SCHEME OR DESIGN FORMAT AS A DRIVER LICENSE ISSUED
32 PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-3153 OR A NONOPERATING IDENTIFICATION LICENSE ISSUED
33 PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-3165.

34 D. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO MUNICIPAL SERVICE ACCESS CARDS THAT ARE
35 ISSUED BY A THIRD PARTY ON BEHALF OF A CITY OR TOWN.

36 Sec. 2. Applicability; legislative findings

37 A. Section 9-500.38, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act,
38 applies to all municipal service access cards issued, reissued or renewed on
39 or after the effective date of this act. A municipal service access card that
40 is issued before the effective date of this act is valid for one year after
41 the effective date of this act.

42 B. The legislature finds that the reliability and standards for
43 issuance of identification cards issued in this state is a matter of
44 statewide concern. The reliability of a validly issued identification card
45 is essential to prevent identity theft and promote commerce.
